12-WEEK MECHANIZED FORESTRY PROGRAM

In this 12-week program, you'll focus on one forestry machine of your choice: harvester, porter/forwarder, or thinning machine (mini excavator with a specialized shear head). The program is designed to maximize hands-on practical training and prepare you for an entry-level position in the field.

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Promote sustainable practices in tree harvesting operations.
- Assess harvest and pre-commercial thinning sites effectively.
- Understand and apply operating responsibilities, principles, and methods to ensure quality in forest harvesting and pre-commercial thinning.
- Evaluate worksite areas and address potential hazards proactively.
- Perform basic preventive maintenance and repairs on forestry equipment.
- Follow health and safety protocols that address both individual and team needs.
- Adhere to regulatory requirements and established forestry harvesting standards.
- Operate equipment safely and efficiently on-site.

FEES: \$14,700 offering a \$2,000 Bursary for eligible students

16-WEEK MECHANIZED FORESTRY PROGRAM

Internship

In this 16-week program, you'll complete the 12-week curriculum while selecting two machines for hands-on practical training. The final 4 weeks include an internship, where you'll work with a contractor on a specific machine at an actual job site.
